




Inference: According to the analysis, 23% strongly agreed, 71% agreed, and 6% disagreed with the relevance of the curriculum in their professional life




Inference: 76 % of the respondents agreed that the aims and objectives of the syllabus were well-defined and clear. Whereas 4% of the students disagreed with the statement.
















































